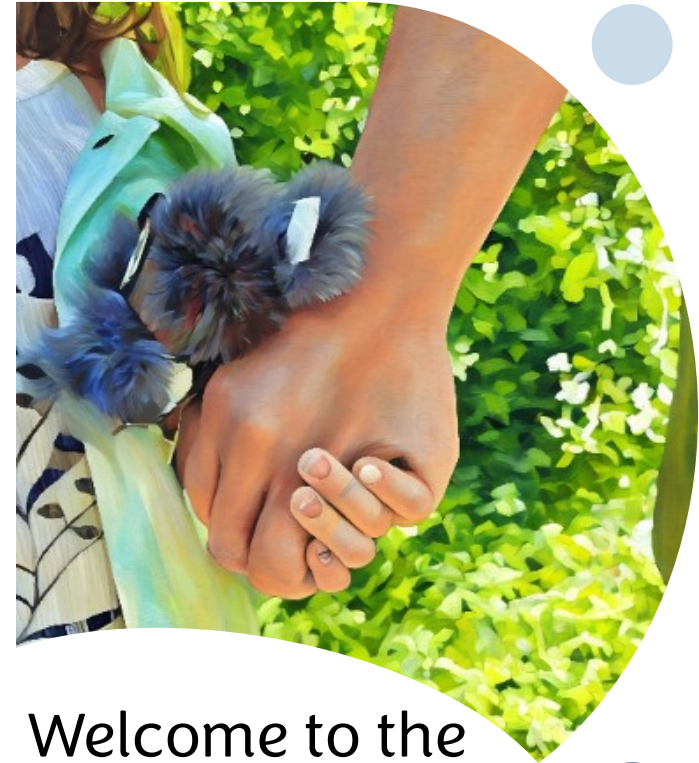

At Kokkedal School, we work closely together for your child across **teaching assistants, teachers & school leadership.**

- A good start to school is crucial for the rest of a child's education



In the nursery class, we prepare your child for a long school life. That is why our classrooms are arranged with different themes that help to vary and differentiate play and teaching. We also have a large playground that encourages many different play activities.

With us, children's well-being, development, and learning are based on an educational approach focusing on play, children's communities, and learning. This means that every day includes play on the timetable.

When children play, opportunities for participation are opened up for each child, inclusive communities are formed, and safe learning environments are created.

Through play, children develop social skills and gain valuable experiences in overcoming challenges and being part of a social community. They learn to include others, to negotiate, to cope with rejection, and to explore their own limits.

Our focus is on developing children's social skills through play. At the same time, daily life is also characterized by academic lessons in Danish, maths, art, and music.

We look forward to a year full of learning in the nursery class together with your child.

Play on the timetable:

In the last lesson of the day, the early years staff plan and carry out play and activities with a particular focus on developing social skills.

The staff introduce different play themes that are familiar from nursery. These might include role play and drama or board games.

Groups on the timetable:

Three times a week, we divide all the children into six small groups. Each group works with an activity of either academic or playful character.

Over a period of 14 days, all children take part in each of the current activities.

Example of activities over 14 days:

- Danish (initial sounds) – Danish (vowels)
- Mathematics (numbers) – Mathematics (addition)
- 3D Drawing – Rhythm & Singing
